Independent Study Policy

Overview

Veritas Collegiate Academy supports students in pursuing academic interests beyond our standard curriculum through independent study via online courses. This policy outlines the guidelines for enrolling in and completing such courses.

Enrollment

Course Selection: Students may enroll in an online course through Veritas Online School, to pursue subjects not offered at Veritas Collegiate Academy during the academic year. Registration: Students must independently register for the chosen online course through the website

Cost: Students are responsible for any fees associated with the online course, as outlined by the course provider.

Course Management

Scheduling: Students may utilize their free period(s) at Veritas Collegiate Academy to work on their online course. However, all coursework and assignments must be managed independently by the student.

Autonomy: Online courses, including those from Veritas Online School, are separate from the Veritas National Landing campus curriculum. The school does not provide direct oversight or academic support for these courses.

Grading and Transcripts

Transcripts: Upon completion, the online course provider will issue a separate transcript to the student, which is independent of the Veritas National Landing academic record. Report Cards: Grades earned in online courses will not be included in the Veritas National Landing report card or GPA calculations.

Responsibilities

Students are responsible for meeting all deadlines, completing coursework, and adhering to the policies of the online course provider.

Veritas National Landing encourages students to communicate with their academic advisor to ensure the chosen course aligns with their educational goals.
